What is your impression of William Blake in the graphic novel? And how do you see him through his art in this exhibition? Does your view and perception of Blake's paintings change after you have learned more about him?



WILLIAM BLAKE AND CATHERINE BOUCHER MARRIED ON 18 AUGUST 1782.




















"... terrors appear'd in the Heavens above And in Hell beneath, & a mighty & awful change threatened the earth. The American War began.















































William Blake's Universe
